


# PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV IN CANADA

Canada doesn't have a single HIV epidemic. HIV prevalence is concentrated in different populations across the country.



**EXPOSURE CATEGORY**

- Men who have sex with men
- Men who have sex with men and inject drugs
- Injection drug use
- Heterosexual people, not including those born in countries where HIV is endemic
- Heterosexual people born in countries where HIV is endemic

**Source:** Based on 2011 estimates, the most recently available regional estimates from the Public Health Agency of Canada. Exposure categories are based on a hierarchical classification at the time of diagnosis. Figures do not add up to 100% as they do not include the negligible percentage from the exposure category of 'Other'.

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
