## Undetectable = Untransmittable

People with HIV who take medicine as prescribed and get and keep an undetectable viral load have effectively no risk of transmitting HIV to their HIV-negative sexual partners.

## IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN U=U AS A PREVENTION PLAN:

- Talk to your partner. There is still a legal risk if you do not disclose your HIV status to your partner.
- Take your prescribed HIV medications daily.
- See your HIV care provider and have your blood tested regularly to monitor your viral load. Condoms should still be used to prevent other STIs and pregnancy.
- Continue to take your medications every day and see your HIV care team for routine blood work every 3 to 6 months.
