

# HIV Testing Day Summary 2024

Community-based organizations across Saskatchewan coordinated the first province-wide HIV testing day on June 27, 2017 in response to high rates of HIV infection in the province. The initiative garnered national attention and is now observed across Canada as National HIV Testing Day with the purpose of promoting and offering HIV testing to educate, reduce stigma, and normalize HIV testing.

Saskatchewan hosted its **6th annual** province-wide HIV Testing Day.\*



The Saskatchewan Minister of Health proclaimed **June 27, 2024** to be the **"National HIV Testing Day"** in Saskatchewan.

Each year, targeted testing fairs and awareness events are organized throughout the province by community-based organizations in collaboration with the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA), First Nations Inuit Health Branch (FNIHB), and the Northern Inter-Tribal Health Authority (NITHA).

## In 2024:

- **9 HIV testing and awareness events** happened in **7 locations** across the province.
- **Approximately 1,237 people attended** these events.
- **111 people were tested** for HIV.
- **98 HIV self-test kits** were distributed.

\*Due to pandemic restrictions, there was no Saskatchewan HIV Testing Day in 2020 and 2021.
